- Data analysis and application of statistical software packages (SPSS etc) in social research.
- Thesis and report writings.

The workshop is open to young faculty members and students pursuing MPhil and PhD programs in Humanities, Social Sciences and Allied Disciplines. Application Requirement: Submit a 1500 words research proposal along with statement of interest and a brief bio.
