EC-2019 (III): Reso. 05 a High Court Judge (Retd) had been appointed to enquire into this case as to the Regular Departmental Action for major penalty against Prof. M. Altaf Khan as recommended by the CBI in case No. RC.EOU-1-2009-E0005.



As the nature and course of action of another CBI Case No. RC-MA1 2009 A0056 is similar, hence the Majlis after due consideration has approved that this case may also be enquired into by the same High Court Judge (Retd) as appointed in the CBI Case No. RC.EOU-1-2009-E0005 in pursuance of EC Resolution No. 05 dated 27.06.2019.
