**World Environment Day Celebrations: JMI organizes Extension Lecture
Technology and E-Waste Management**

The Department of Computer Engineering, Jamia Millia Islamia(JMI) organised an online extension lecture on “**Technology and E-Waste Management**” on 31st May 2023 from by Dr. Anwesha Borthakur. Dr. Anwesha, Marie Skłodowska Curie Postdoctoral Fellow who is presently working as a researcher at the Katholieke Universiteit Leuven (KU Leuven), Belgium delivered the lecture. She has worked on E-waste management and policies for over a decade now. She also works on textile waste management towards a circular system considering all three phases of the textile lifecycle – the production, consumption, and disposal of textiles.

The lecture was attended by Ph.D., Post Graduate as well as Undergraduate students of the department. The session was very interactive as several queries were raised by the audience.
